

Camp Cedar Ridge Guest Policies

Check in time: 3:00 PM; Check out time: 11:00 AM (except by special arrangement)

- 1. Harassment in any form based on religion, spirituality, sexual preferences, race, gender age, or physical ability is not allowed.
- Parking is only permitted in the Upper Parking Lot, the Event Parking Lot, or other parking spaces designated by staff. Cars may be parked by the house, lodge and designated location for the bunkhouses, for loading and unloading only. There is no parking by the camp store or the dining room.
- 3. Quiet hours are between 10:00 PM-7:00 AM unless by special permission.
- 4. Smoking is allowed in designated areas only. No illegal drugs are allowed on the property or persons under influence of illegal drugs.
- 5. Shoes are required in the Dining Room.
- 6. No nails, screws, duct or masking tape can be used to secure items. Painter's tape and push pins are permissible.
- 7. The use of water balloons is prohibited.
- 8. No firearms permitted.
- 9. Guests should turn off lights and heaters and leave doors closed at check-out. All new damage will be the group's responsibility.
- 10. Guests access Rock Creek at their own risk.
- 11. Fires are allowed in firepits, at times during the year when fires are permitted. Fires must be prearranged with the Camp Cedar Ridge staff and use Camp Cedar Ridge firewood or approved outside firewood.
- 12. Guests should never enter the pool area unless the gate is unlocked. Guests must observe all the pool rules and instructions of the lifeguard. A lifeguard is required is there are guests under 18 on the site.
- 13. Use of the slip and slide is only allowed while supervised by CCR staff.
- 14. Staff housing areas are private and should not be entered by guests without an invitation.

Dogs

- Dogs must be on a leash.
- Dogs may not be tied out or tied to trees.
- When away from your dog, it must be in a kennel.
- Dogs are not to be confined to your vehicle in extreme heat or cold.
- Dogs are not allowed in the dining hall or shower house.
- If your dog is aggressive or a nuisance, you will be asked to remove your dog from the property.
- Owners must pick up after their dogs.
