# About Camp Cedar Ridge: Rooted and Rising in Community and Service

## Our Mission: Discover the Good

Camp Cedar Ridge provides facilities for youth, adult, family, and organizational events. Camp provides educational programs with a focus on life-long learning, social-emotional development, philosophical curiosity, creative arts, diversity, and cultural responsiveness. Camp programs foster a love of nature and the environment through access to the outdoors, the promotion of eco-literacy, sustainable practices, and a healthy lifestyle with an emphasis on the whole person.



## Camp Cedar Ridge

The camp is nestled on 32 wooded acres in Vernonia, Oregon, about 45 minutes from Portland. We are a year-round nonprofit retreat center where people come to gather, rest, learn, celebrate, and reconnect—with nature, with one another, and with themselves. ## Vernonia Village Youth and Family Enrichment Program

This afterschool program is a collaboration between Vernonia School District and Camp Cedar Ridge. Children receive homework help, tutoring, and enrichment activities in areas such as arts, music, STEM, life skills, work readiness, sports and physical activity, and creative projects. ## Loggin' Laundry

When it was announced in 2025 that the laundromat in Vernonia would be closing, Camp Cedar Ridge recognized how essential this resource is, both for our operations and the town of Vernonia. We purchased the business, held a grand opening in April 2025, and renamed it *Loggin' Laundry*, in honor of the town's history and logging roots. # Community care in action

Camp Cedar Ridge is proud to partner with local residents and community resource agencies to provide support and assistance for our neighbors in need.

## The Shower Power Program

If you need access to a shower, you can stop by the Communication Station at 736 Bridge Street, #4 to pick up shower tokens at no charge. The tokens can be used at Anderson Park, and each person may receive up to 2 tokens per day, with 5 minutes of water per token.

## Warm Up Round Up: Spread the Warmth

The **Warm Up Round Up program** is a simple and caring way our community can help neighbors stay warm this season. New or gently used blankets can be dropped off at Loggin' Laundry any day from 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. We will wash them and put them out for anyone who needs one to take.

Now through May 11, if you need warm, winter clothing, simply ask for a *Camp Cedar Ridge voucher* at Bargains on Bridge. It's good for coats, jackets, scarves, hats, and gloves.

## Community Freedge + Koko's Corner

If you have extra food to share, drop it off in the **Community Freedge at Loggin' Laundry**. In addition to the refrigerator, a dry goods shelf is also available for items that do not need to be refrigerated. Or come by and pick up what you need.

**Koko's Corner** is a special spot for donations of pet food, making it easy to care not only for people, but for their animals as well.

## Laundry Love Program

If laundry costs are a strain right now, the **Laundry Love program at Loggin' Laundry** is here to help. Laundry Love is part of a nationwide effort that helps cover the cost of washing clothes and bedding for individuals and families who are struggling financially.

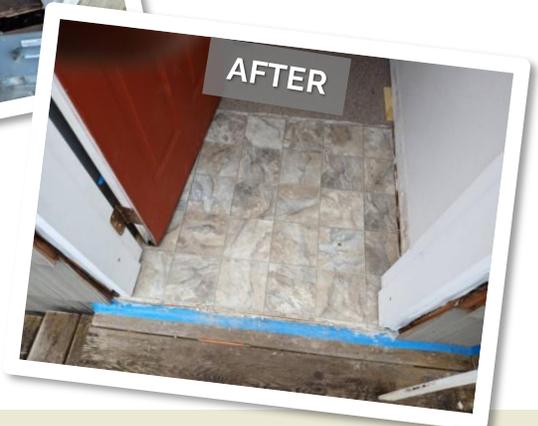

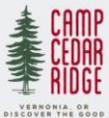

There is a commuter rate available for local residents to participate without spending the night!

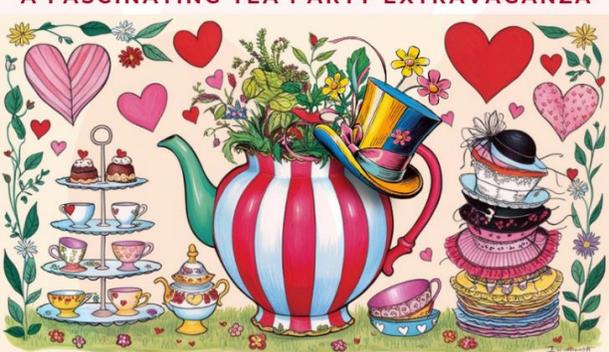

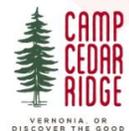
